Brass Quintet

The Brass Quintet is the most versatile component of the Band of the United States Air Force Reserve. With a repertoire spanning five centuries, they are equally at home performing everything from Renaissance and Baroque music all the way to jazz, popular music, marches and patriotic selections. The group is also dedicated to performing original compositions for Brass Quintet, such as John Cheetham's "Scherzo," and Eric Ewazen's "Colchester Fantasy."

A mainstay of the "Hay House in Music" chamber music series in Macon, GA, the Brass Quintet performs a variety of different military and community relations concerts throughout the southeast, including Memorial Day celebrations at Andersonville National Historic Site, The Air University Honorary Degree Ceremony for Tom Brokaw, and the Georgia Sports Hall of Fame Induction Ceremony. The members of the brass quintet have music degrees from Baldwin Wallace College, Indiana University, The Peabody Institute of Music, Rowan University, Tennessee Technological University, the University of Georgia, and the University of Nevada Reno.

The members of the Brass Quintet are all professional Air Force musicians working in support of Air Force and Air Force Reserve recruiting and community relations objectives.
